## FOOD AND EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS

The Food Program:

- Distributes 280,000 pounds of food per year to income qualified families in the Santa Ynez Valley and Los Alamos.
- Provides food to 1250 unduplicated people each year, up to 26 times a year.

• Supplements the USDA and donated food from the Food Bank with locally donated canned goods and other staples. The bi-weekly distributions are made

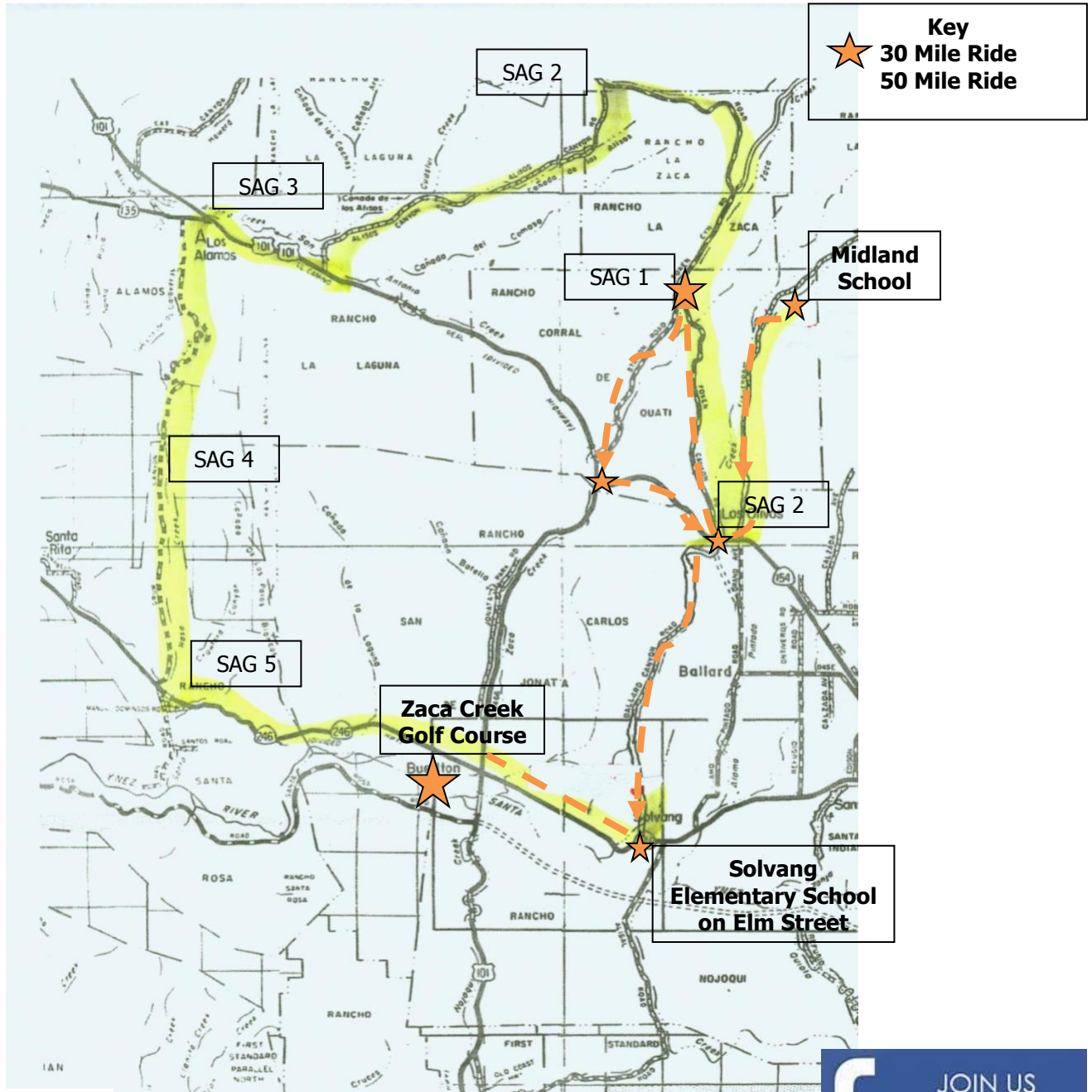
possible with the help of up to 20 volunteers, who unload, bag and distribute the food.

The Emergency Solutions program is designated to prevent homelessness and offers people help with:

- Rent, utilities and other expenses that may cause someone to become homeless or to live in sub-standard conditions.
- Emergency transportation and food
